

The Ark of the Covenant

Several years ago Ron Wyatt said he found the ark of the covenant... I believe him. Lets have a look at a couple clues... Ron said the ark is in a cave directly underneath the cross hole that he found on Golgotha. Previously people brought "blemish free" animals to sacrifice. The priest would transfer the blood of these animals to the brass covering of the alter. Several years later Jesus Christ would take the place of these animals. Christ who was also "blemish free" would sprinkle His blood directly on the mercy seat thereby anointing or consecrating the "new covenant" or second covenant...

* Hebrews 8:6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. * Hebrews 8:7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.

The Method: In order to have the precious blood of our LORD and Saviour obtain eternal redemption for us, It had to touch something that is sacred.

- sacred- set apart for the service or worship of a deity; blessed, divine, holy, sanctified

Ron said he found the ark of the covenant twenty feet down from the cross hole. He said that he broke the end off of a tape measure, and pushed it through a "fissure" located on the corner of the cross hole. He said the tape reached all the way from the cross hole to the opening directly above the mercy seat. This opening or "fissure" is located in the "ceiling" of a cave that sits directly beneath the cross hole.

The blood had to travel twenty feet... * I John 5:6 This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because

the Spirit is truth.

This is how the blood traveled
twenty feet...

* John 19:34 But one of the
soldiers with a spear pierced his
side, and forthwith came there
out blood and water.

* Hebrews 9:12 Neither by the
blood of goats and calves, but by
his own blood he entered in once
into the holy place, having obtained
eternal redemption for us.

OK folks... here is a perfect
example of a situation where
Christ put Himself in a position

Where blood would be used, along with something referred to as "the holy place." Since Jesus Christ was not here when the ark of the covenant was associated with such a place, Hebrews 9:12: **†** must be speaking of the crucifixion...

The only logical explanation that would put Jesus Christ, His blood, and a location referred to as "holy place" all together simultaneously. This is a perfect match to the scenario Ron Wyatt spoke of.

* EXODUS 26:33 And thou shalt hang up the veil under the taches, that thou mayest bring in thither within the veil the ark of the testimony: and the veil shall divide unto you between the holy place and the most holy.

This division will be abolished the exact moment the precious blood of our LORD and Saviour sprinkled on the gold covering of the mercy seat. ~~God~~ ^{God}

* Hebrews 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? * Hebrews 9:15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that **were** under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

Hebrews 9:14 proves that this was exactly the time of the crucifixion... it says "offered Himself without spot to God". The next verse (15) associates His death with the precise moment when the "new testament" meets something called the "first testament." The verse states "that **were** under the first testament", and the word "were" is italicized... "were" is past tense, meaning "in the past."

* Hebrews 9:19 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people, * Hebrews 9:20 saying, this is the blood of the testament which God hath enjoined unto you. * Hebrews 9:21 Moreover he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the ministry. * Hebrews 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

This proves that Moses used blood to "set in motion" the "first testament" Years later "Jesus Christ would use His blood to set in motion a "new testament" abolishing the "book of the law" that was contrary to us. The only possible way to get the blood to the mercy seat was to move the ark of the Covenant under ground, directly

under the exact spot someone would place the hole for "the Cross" that our Saviour would die on. Jesus Christ bled from thorns on the top of His head, and from a hole in His side, and from nails in his feet down the wooden cross pole. The blood gathered and after He died the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

- rent - a tear; to split apart with violence

This tear or "fissure" Ron Wyatt discovered, allowed the blood and water to spill directly on top of the mercy seat. Directly under the mercy seat, inside the ark of the covenant, are the tables of stone containing the "new testament" written by the finger of YAHWEH.

Just because you can't see, something doesn't mean its not there!

Ron said the ark of the
 covenant is in a cave underneath

 where He was pierced by a "crown
 of thorns" down to his side. This
