smote - to strike heavily


* Mark 15:25 And it was the third hour, and they crucified him.

He Hurts


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• Jeer - to mock

* LUKE 23:36 And the soldiers also mocked him, coming to him, and offering him vinegar.


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• reject - to refuse to hear, receive or consider
